Please bring supplies with you to the first day of class. Most products available at: Michael's, JoAnn's, Hobby Lobby & Wal-Mart, **(or from Teri – shown in red)**
Prices will vary depending on where you purchase supplies. **(I have noted average store price ranges in blue)**

Basic Supply List:

Apron or old painting shirt

Paper towels -1 roll

Styrofoam Plates (6)

Pencil & paper,

Water container – use to rinse brushes **or (Teri - Brush Water Basin: \$6.50)**



Brushes: 50536E Artist Variety Brushes 10 PC Sizes Included are Flat 2,6,8,10,12,3/4 script liner 1, 2 and scruffy 1/4" and 3/4" - Golden Taklon synthetic brushes are best. **(\$6.00- \$10.00) (Teri - \$6.00)**



Blending Gel Medium: 867 2oz. Blending Gel Medium **(Approx. \$2-\$3.00) (Teri - \$3.50)**



Acrylic Paints: many good brands are available, it is best to use bottle acrylics instead of tube acrylics. Bright pure colors work best rather than light or pastel colors.

Suggested brands to select from: **Plaid Folk Art Multi-Surface, DecoArt Americana Multi-Surface Paint, Craft Smart Multi-Surface, or Apple Barrel Multi-Surface (Prices range from \$1.59 to 2.89 per 2 oz. bottles) (Teri - \$2.50 per bottle)** Colors needed are: White, Black, Bright Yellow, Bright Red, Bright Blue
